STALL HOLDER INFORMATION – TERMS & CONDITIONS

SITE FEES: \$20 unpowered, additional \$10 payable if insurance required

Site fees must be paid into the BANG account by Thursday, 13 May.

All cancellations must be received in writing to info@bang.org.au at least 48 hours prior to the event. Fees are not refundable after this time.

BUMP IN / BUMP OUT:

Bump In is from 10am with vehicle access via Moreton Terrace (near the Bus Stop) with all unnecessary vehicles to be removed from the Park by 11.40am. **Bump Out commences after 5pm or as determined by Site Manager due to delay of patrons leaving the area.**

No vehicle will be allowed to enter or leave the Park until this time.

INSURANCE & LICENCES:

A copy of your Public Liability insurance will be required. Please email to info@bang.org.au or post to BANG by Thursday, 13 May.

LIGHTING:

All stalls will need to supply their own additional lighting. Battery operated low energy LED lighting is recommended.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. Stall holders agree to leave their allocated site in a clean and tidy state, removing all litter and equipment by 7pm.
2. Under the Fire Safety Regulations, where a stall uses gas or electrical appliances, it is required to have a fire extinguisher for that class of fire, and where a stall uses oils or fats it is required to have a fire blanket.
3. Food must only be prepared according to the Council's food standards.
4. It is the responsibility of the stall holder to provide all electrical leads to operate on the site.
5. All leads must be tagged and tested prior to the event.
6. All marquees must be weighted (clearly visible) to ensure no movement due to strong winds - NO tent pegs allowed.
7. All leads, hoses or other trip hazards must be suitably covered to prevent any trip hazards.
8. All equipment brought onto the site is the responsibility of the stall holder and BANG shall not be held liable for any loss or damage to the property while at the Event for any reason whatsoever.
9. In the case of the Event being cancelled due to inclement weather or other circumstances, a 50% refund will be given. However, if the Event goes ahead at an alternate venue and the stall holder chooses not to attend, no refund will be applied.
10. Allocation of the site is at the discretion of the BANG Committee to best benefit the Event and its patrons.
11. The stall holder agrees to operate their site for the duration of the Event.
12. The allocated site is to be used solely for the purpose specified in this application. No sub-letting will be permitted. No selling, canvassing, hawking, fund raising or distribution of printed or other material will be permitted outside the designated stall area.
13. All stall holders must be aware of the location of the First Aid kit (BANG tent) and all emergency procedures for the site.
14. By signing the Stallholder Application Form, you authorise BANG to use any photography/videotaping taken of your site for any publicity purposes.
15. By signing the Stallholder Application Form, you agree to receive marketing material from BANG from time to time that communicates the activities of BANG.
